SANTA ANA, Calif. (August 16, 2023) – OC Public Libraries is proud to present *A Slice of Literary Orange*, a series featuring keynote speakers throughout the year, in celebration of literacy.

Karin Slaughter, a prolific crime writer, is the author of more than twenty instant *New York Times* bestselling novels, including the Edgar–nominated *Cop Town* and standalone novels *Pretty Girls*, *The Good Daughter*, and *Pieces of Her*. She is published in 120 countries with more than 40 million copies sold across the globe. *Pieces of Her* is a #1 Netflix original series, and *Will Trent*, based on her Will Trent series, is on ABC (and streaming on Hulu in the U.S., and Disney+ internationally). Slaughter is a lifelong supporter of libraries and library programming.
