High Surf Advisory in Effect Wednesday Morning - Friday Afternoon

The National Weather Service has issued an advisory for High Surf in the Coastal Orange County area.

The Advisory warns that West facing beaches will experience 5 to 8 foot waves and surf with local sets to 10 feet beginning on Wednesday morning through Friday afternoon.

This could create hazardous conditions for boaters entering Dana Point Harbor due to waves washing over the jetties.
