High Surf Advisory is Extended Through Sunday Morning

The National Weather Service has issued an extended advisory for High Surf in the Coastal Orange County area.

The Advisory warns that West facing beaches will experience sporadic 5 to 7 foot waves and surf with local sets to 9 feet beginning now through Sunday February 12th.

This could create hazardous conditions for boaters entering Dana Point Harbor due to waves washing over the jetties.
