ARTICLE V. RECORDKEEPING AND FEES: GROUND AMBULANCE

Section 502: Ground Ambulance: Dispatch Records

- I. In addition to those requirements listed in Section 1100.7 of Title 13 of the California Code of Regulations, dispatch logs shall include the following information for each call:
 - A. The last name of the ambulance attendant and the driver.
 - B. An explanation of any delays during a call.
 - C. A record of the notification made to the local fire department dispatch center when a request has been received for an emergency response from other than a public safety agency.
- II. Each ambulance service operator shall have documentation that a dispatcher is on duty 24 hours a day.
