# Senior Health Outreach & Prevention Program SHOPP

SHOPP is a County of Orange, Health Care Agency community outreach and home visitation program for low income, uninsured, underinsured or underserved adults. All persons age 45 and above who have an unmet health care need are eligible with priority given to frail older adults.

Services are provided by Public Health Nurses and Behavioral Health Older Adult Specialists.

## MISSION

The mission of SHOPP is to promote optimal health for older adults and underserved adults living in the community.

## SHOPP Services

### Health Screening

Health and nutrition screenings by licensed public health nurses

### Behavioral Health

#### Assessment & Evaluation

Assessment of current behavioral functioning including individual strengths and support systems

### Intervention

Crisis and problem resolution through short-term counseling and case management

### Linkages

Connection of client and family to community services and resources

### Case Management

Coordination and collaboration of client services and resources with community providers

### Consultation/Education

Community, service provider, client and family consultation and education regarding health and aging
