County of Orange Hosts Midway City Community Cleanup Day

(Midway City, CA) – Staff from two County of Orange departments – OC Waste & Recycling and OC Public Works – will partner with residents to help create a safer, cleaner, and healthier Midway City at Community Cleanup Day on Saturday, March 3rd from 8 a.m. to noon.

Rainbow Environmental Services will place 10 large dumpsters throughout Midway City, which community members can use to dispose of or recycling large household items for disposal at no charge. Common household items include: sofas, chairs, desks, tables, shelving units, mattresses, refrigerators, stoves, washers, dryers, water heaters, ovens, lawn furniture and children's toys.

The locations of the dumpsters for disposal or recycling of these common household items are as follows:

During the event, a free E-waste collection will be held at the Vietnamese Alliance Church parking lot, 8141 Washington Ave., Midway City, CA 92655. Residents can drop off electronic components like computer monitors (any size, any kind), televisions (any size, any kind), computers, laptops, gaming systems, fax machines, copiers, printers, typewriters, calculators, radio/stereo equipment, and DVD/VCR Players.

The household hazardous waste materials listed below should be disposed of properly at an Orange County Household Hazardous Waste Collection Center. This is a free service. For the convenience of Midway City unincorporated area residents, there is a collection center at 17121

Nichols St., Gate 6, Huntington Beach, CA 92647. The County's Collection Centers are open Tuesday through Saturday, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.
