Eco Crew Tips for Saving Your Planet



Choose the right bin. Most communities have three waste receptacles – household waste, yard waste, and recyclables. It's important to know which items belong in which bin. Check with your local municipality to see what's allowed and what's not.

Also consider products such as paints, oils, and batteries—these items are categorized as "household hazardous waste." Household hazardous waste products should be disposed of differently. These products should be taken to your local Household Hazardous Waste Collection Center.
