1. Approval of Meeting Minutes for October 13, 2011

The meeting minutes for October 13, 2011 were moved for approval by Fred Ameri and seconded by Joe Lambert.

2. Planning Division Update

Michael Balsamo reported the following:

- The OCFA and State Fire Marshall have issued the new state Fire Hazard Severity Zone maps. Further discussions of Ember Zones are expected to occur at a later time.
- Plan Check revenue has shown signs of improvement for the past few months.
- Due to the Sunset Beach annexation, the Coastal Commission is now the lead permitting agency on all new Coastal Development Permits; the County will continue to issue building permits until further notice.

3. Water Quality Permits

Mary Anne Skorpanich, from OC Watersheds, provided a brief training on the County model WQMP requirements and current obstacles. She explained that the goal is to determine the most technically and economically feasible plan.

Michael Balsamo mentioned that the Board of Supervisors adopted its
Legislative Platform with the goal to address the two Water Quality Boards
(Santa Ana and San Diego), to discuss the possibility of consolidating
authority under one region in order to prevent complications for local
agencies and the public within Orange County.

4. Subdivision Plan Check

David Shepherd addressed the DPRC's concern regarding the current void of inhouse staff for Subdivision plan check. He reported that Planned Communities is currently working with four different consultant firms to provide the necessary resource required for any particular issue. In order to prevent any inconsistencies caused by the different plan check groups, County managers are undertaking quality control reviews. He also stated that they are working with OC Survey to develop flow charts and checklists that will clearly outline the submittal process.

5. Authorization Letters

DPRC members continued their discussion of "Owner-Builder" and "Agent Authorization" forms, and Hadi advised that authorization letters will not be required on a per permit basis for large tract developments.

6. OCPW Standard Plans Manual

Carl Taylor reported that there is continued progress on the Standard Plan Update. He is working with Hadi Tabatabaee and Mahrooz Ilkhanipour, as there is particular focus on the Building and Safety Standard Plans. They are hoping to have some of the revised standards approved at the next meeting.

7. Other Business

DPRC members discussed the site prioritization for NPDES inspection frequency which was distributed by Ruby Maldonado. NPDES inspections can occur at any time, and are categorized into a low/medium/high priority based on the size of the project.
