DANA POINT FESTIVAL OF WHALES SAND SCULPTING COMPETITION MATERIALS AND RULES

MATERIALS

- ❖ Use of Sand within the designated building area (10' x 20')
- No adhesives permitted
- ❖ Water containers may be filled prior to the start of sculpting.
- ❖ You may have an unlimited number of water carriers.
- No sand coloring of any type allowed. No dye, food coloring or jello.
- Naturally occurring plants and inanimate objects from the sea (such as seaweed, shells without animals, etc.) may be used. NO COLLECTING on-site.
- OC Parks asks that you do not pass out any literature, coupons, or other items while at the contest area.
- No additional signage permitted (other than what is provided by the sand sculpting organizers) within your designated space.

TOOLS

- All hand tools (masonry, garden or household implements, shovels and tampers) are allowed.
- ❖ Pails, buckets, watering cans or hand pump sprayers are allowed.
- ❖ Forms are permitted but must be removed prior to judging. NOTE: No sculpted forms allowed.
- Compacted sand must be sculpted and altered by hand upon removal of forms.

COMPETITION

There will be first, second, third and fourth place finishes for the entire event. All judges' decisions are final.
