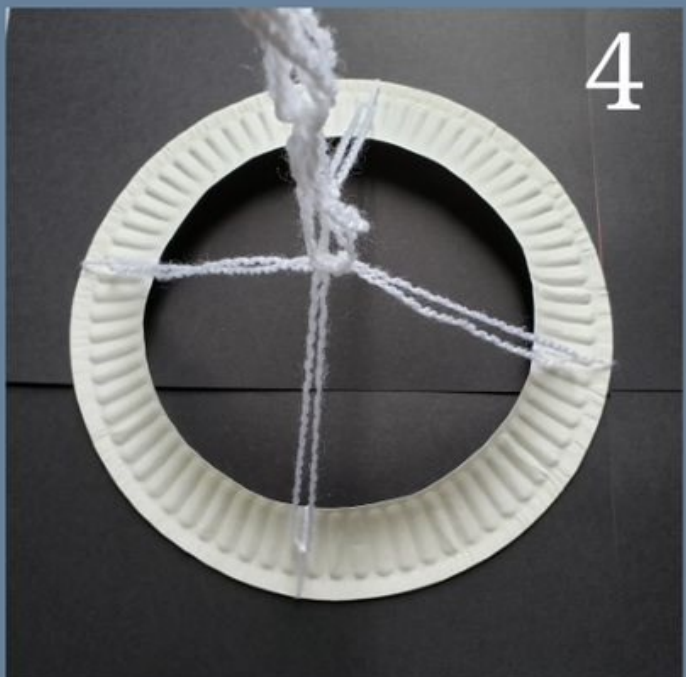
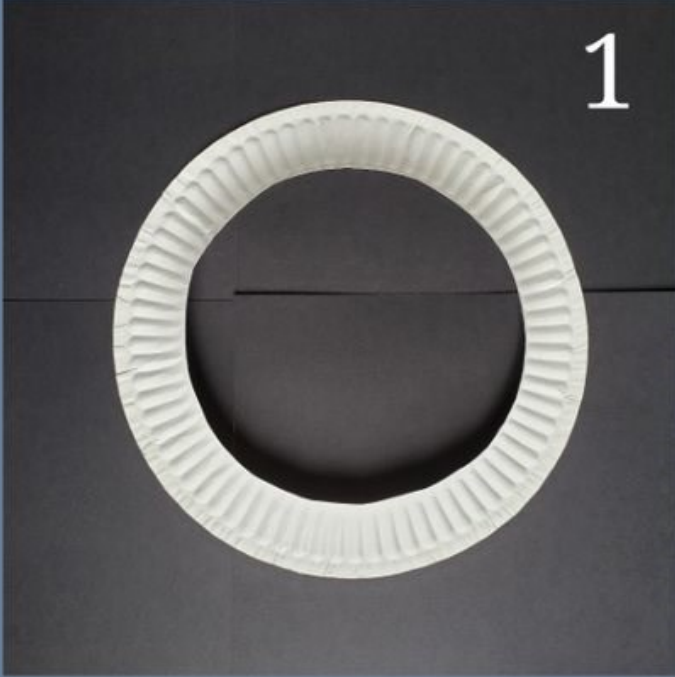


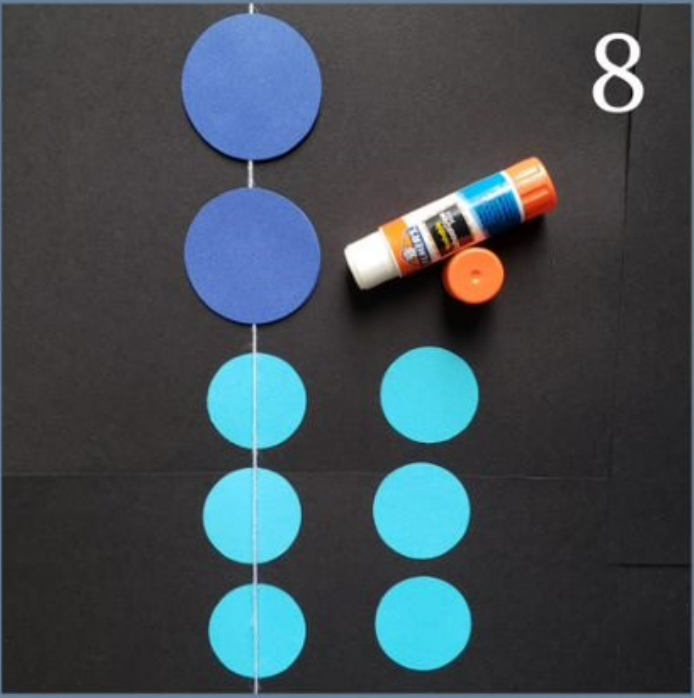
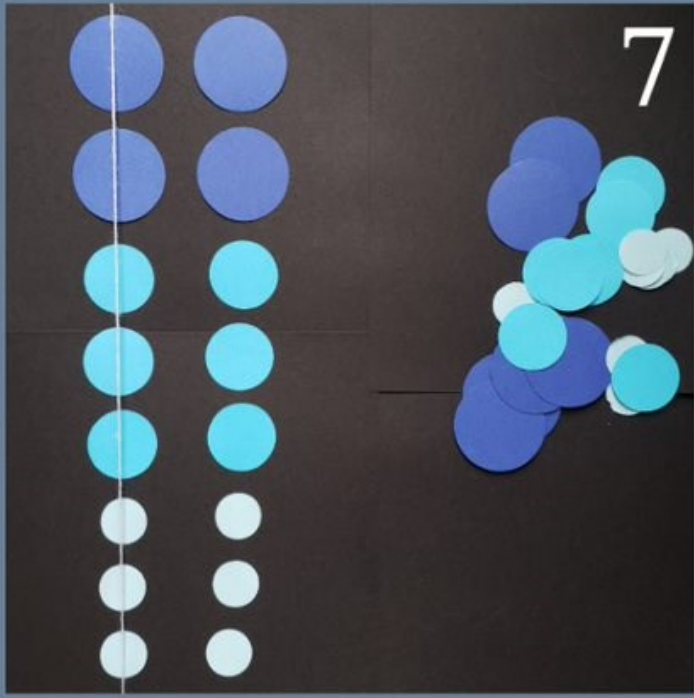
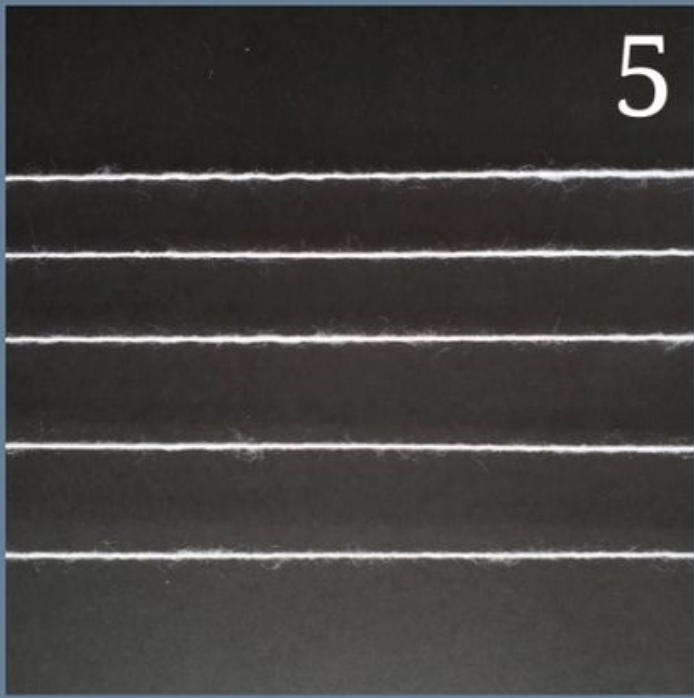
Paper Chandelier

Supplies: 1 paper plate, paper, string, scissors, glue

1. Cut out the inside of the paper plate, leaving a circle frame.

2. Cut 4 strings, each about a foot in length.

3. Mark 4 equal quarters on the frame. Tie a string at each mark, leaving a long tail.

4. Tie all the tails together above the frame. Form a loop at the end for hanging.

5. Cut 12 strings for the chains. Cut more strings if you want more chains. Vary the length of the chains. Length depends on how long you want the chains to hang.

6. Cut paper into shapes of your choice: circles, hearts, etc. Choose any color or paper type. You can write or draw on them. Get creative!

7. Cut doubles of your shapes. Line them up and space them out as desired for your chain. Place one string on top, leaving a tail for tying.

8. Glue the double of each shape on top, sandwiching the string. Repeat down the chain.

9. Tie your chains around the circle frame. Take care to balance the chains around the frame.

10. You are finished! Hang your chandelier proudly.
