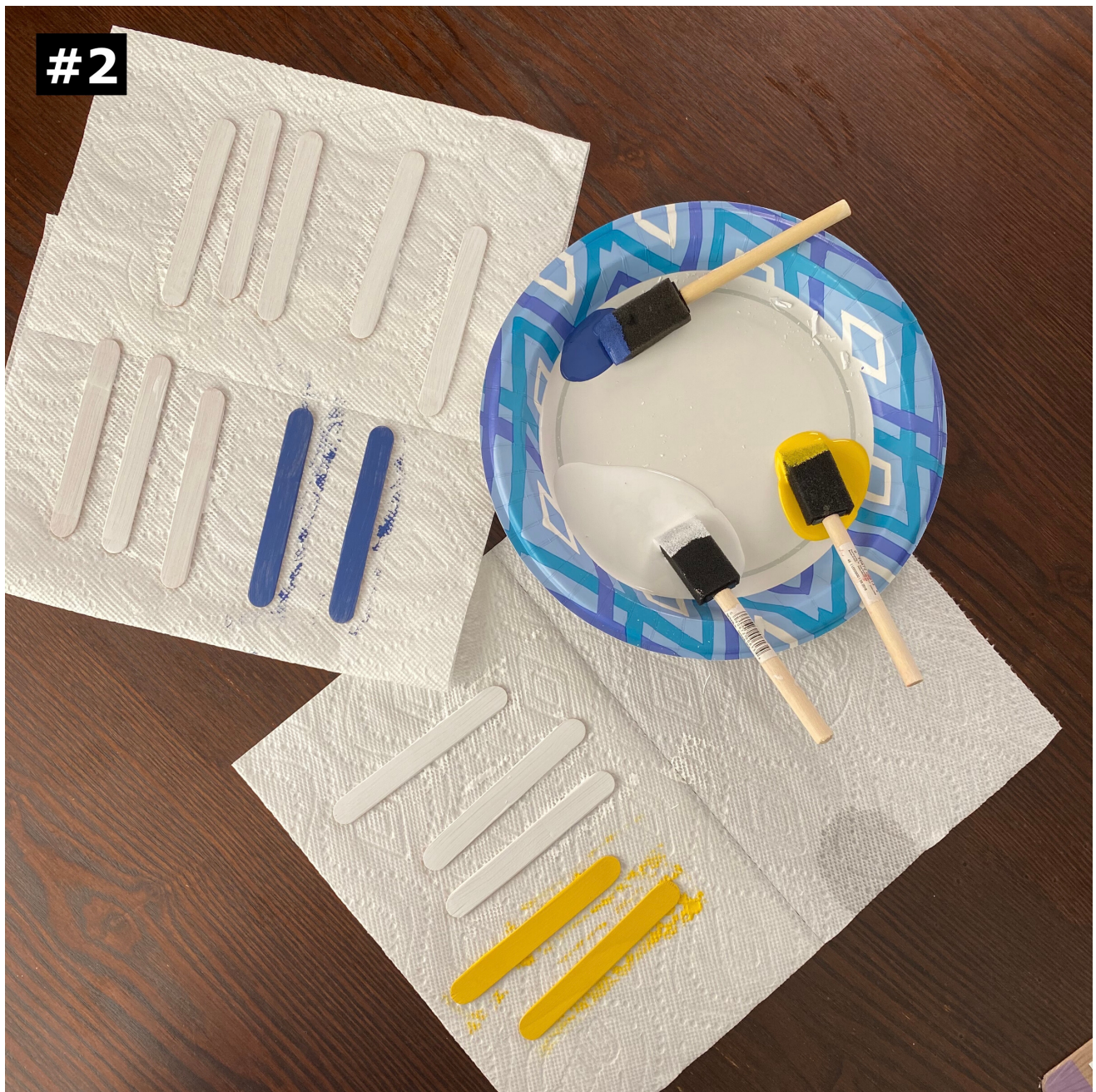

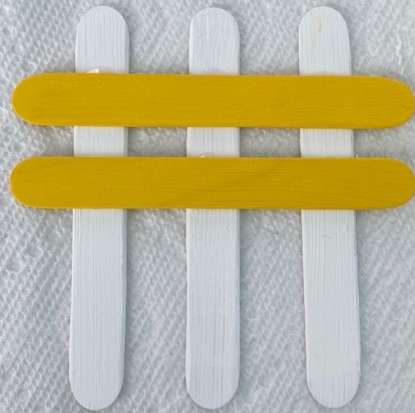

#1 Supplies

Popsicle Sticks (5 sticks per plant marker)

Paint

Paint Brush

Sharpies

Glue

Paper Plate

Paper Towels

Decorations (optional)

#2

Lay down the paper towel and prepare paint by putting on paper plate. Then, paint 5 popsicle sticks (front and back) however you like!

Once you are happy with your creation, let dry.

#3

Once dry, lay 3 popsicle sticks vertically next to each other (1 to 2" apart).

Then, glue and place 2 popsicle sticks horizontally on top of the 3 popsicle sticks (1 to 2" apart).

Place the sticks higher, because the bottom part will be placed in the dirt.

#4

Use a sharpie to write plant information on the 2 horizontal sticks. Optional: use fun decorations to jazz up plant marker!

Once happy with final creation, insert marker near the plant. You now will always know what plants are blooming in your garden!
