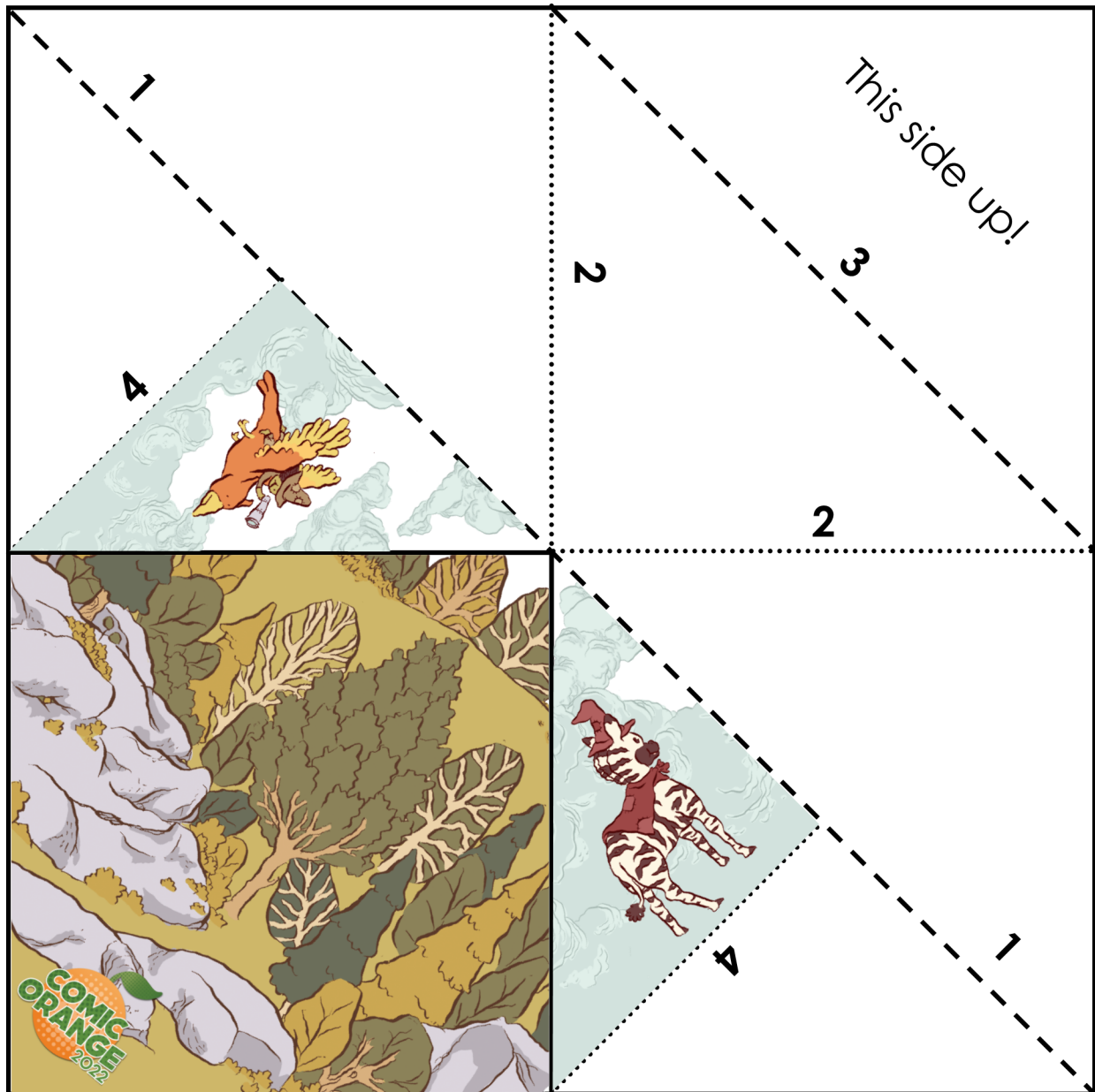


DIY ORIGAMI CORNER BOOKMARK

OC Public Libraries' Comic Orange invites you to read beyond the beaten path!
Use this template to make your own bookmark to slip over the corner of a page.



FOLDING INSTRUCTIONS:

Cut out the whole square along the solid lines.

Fold in half along dashed line 1, so that the words "This side up!" are facing you. You now have a triangle with the long side on the bottom.

Fold up the corners along both dotted lines 2, and then unfold.

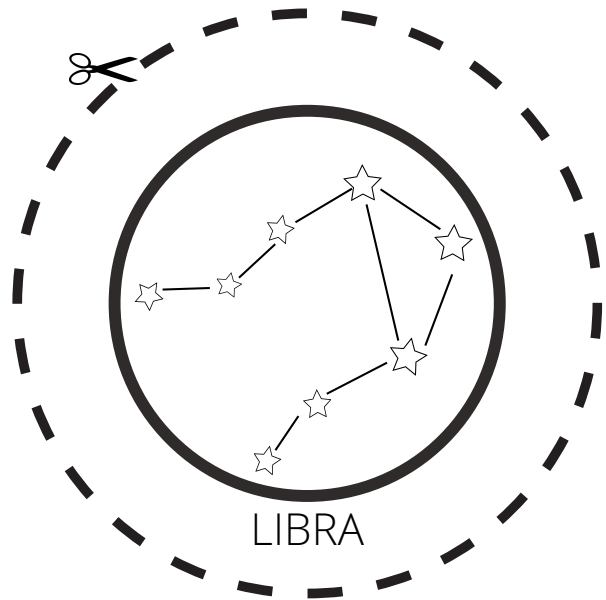
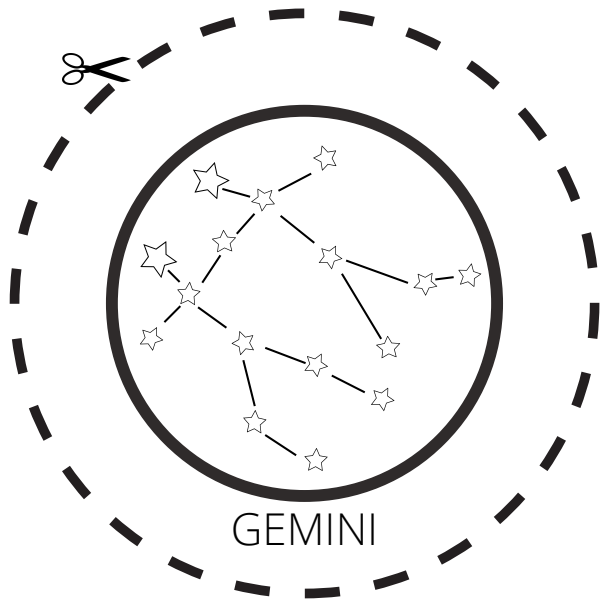
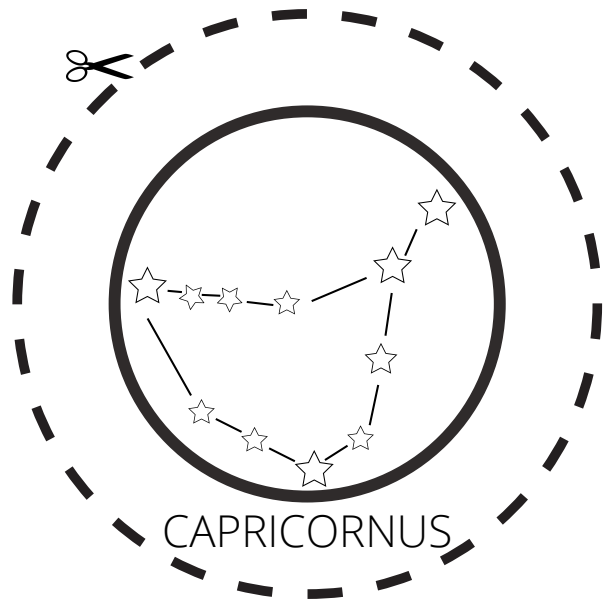
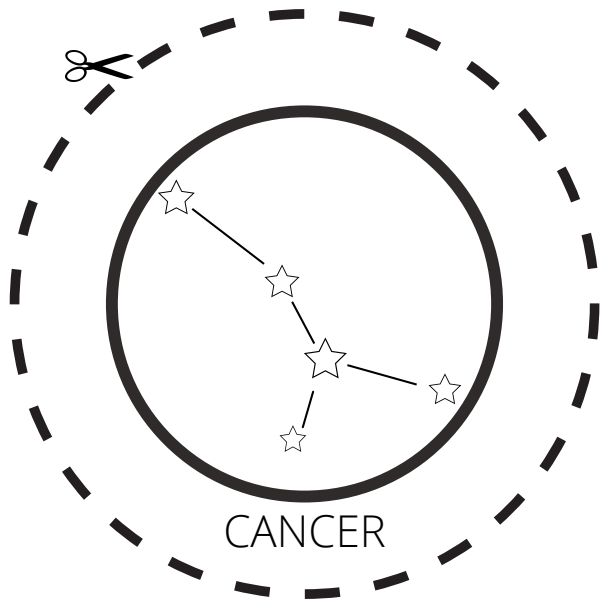
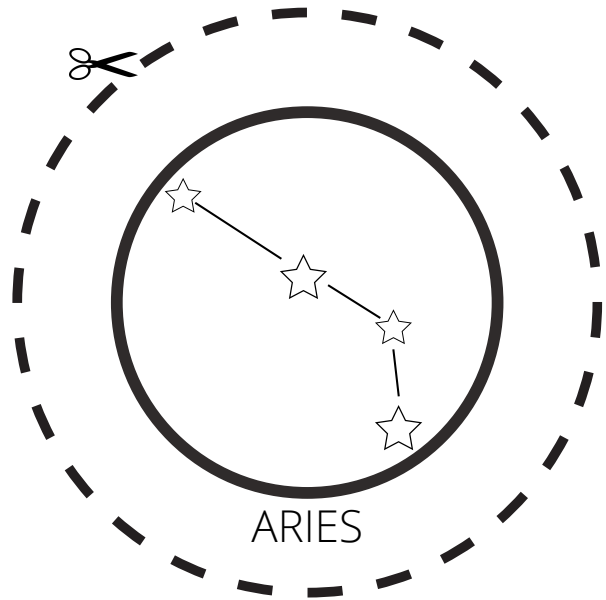
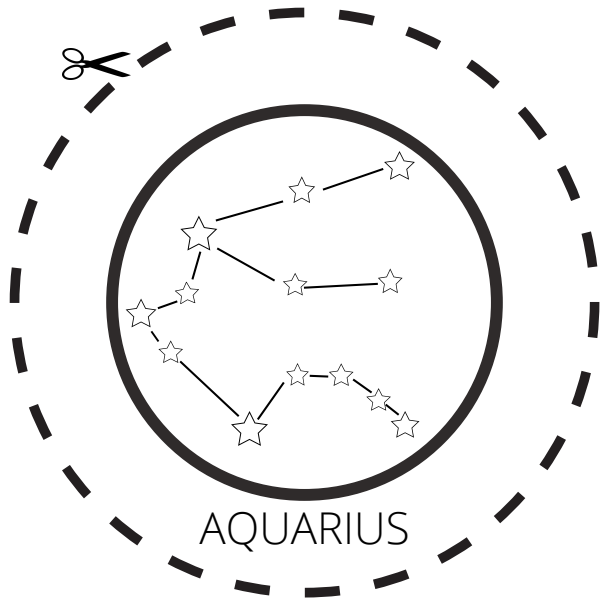
Fold-down the front sheet only (the one that says "This side up!") along dashed line 3. Re-fold the corners along dotted lines 2.

Tuck in the top points by folding along dotted line 4. Enjoy your new bookmark!



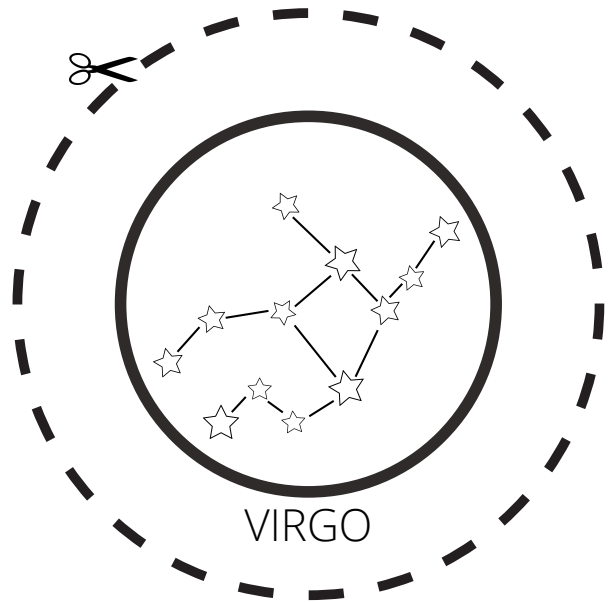
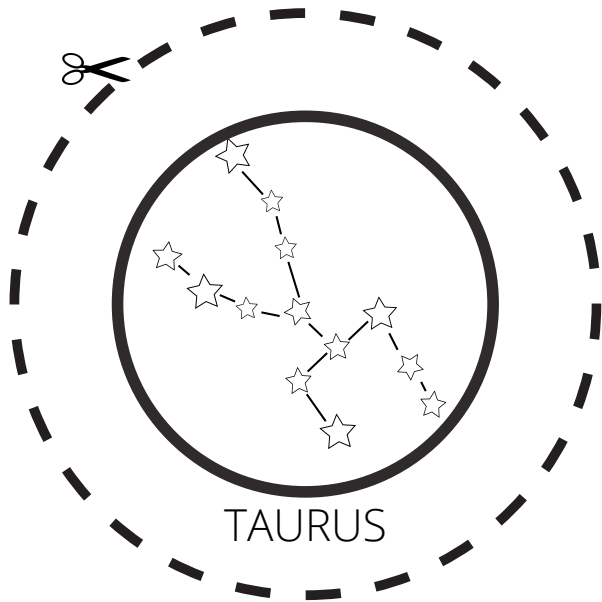
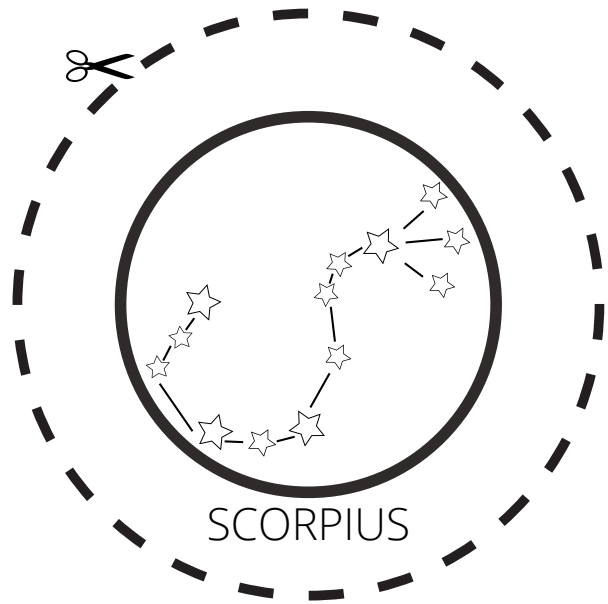
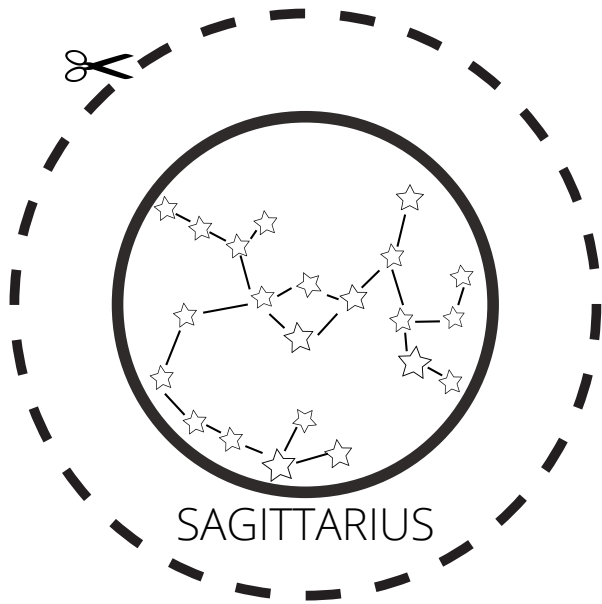
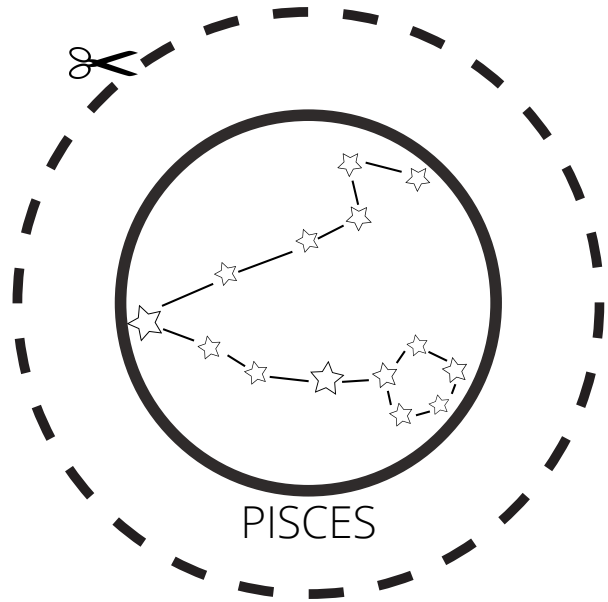
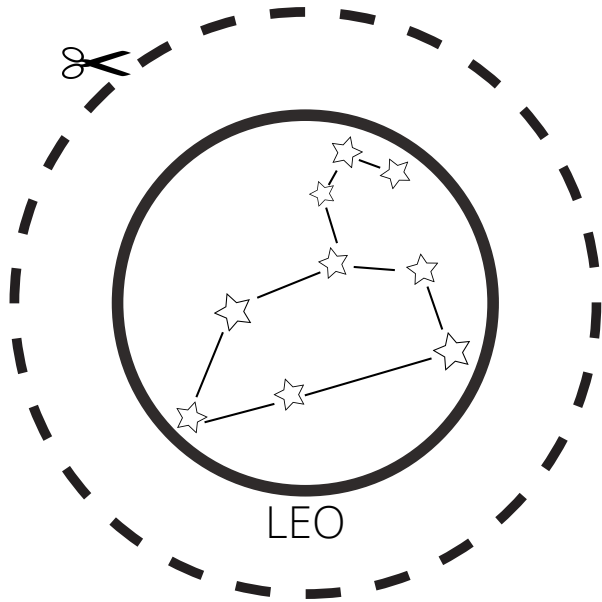


Flashlight Constellations

Flashlight Constellations Instructions

Materials:

- Flashlight Constellations activity sheets
- Flashlight with a round opening.
- Thin cardboard from cereal box or cardstock.
- Pushpin or needle
- Glue
- Tape (optional)

Step 1:

Cut out each of the circles along the dotted lines. You can adjust the size to fit with your flashlight.

Step 2:

Glue the circles to a thin piece of cardboard or cardstock to make them sturdier. After the glue dries, cut out the circles again.

Step 3:

Puncture a hole into each star using a pushpin or needle. Make sure the punctures are large enough to allow light to shine through.

Step 4:

Place circle in front of the flashlight. Some tape might be needed to secure the circle.

Step 5:

In a dark room, shine the flashlight against a wall to see the stars. Have fun!



Solar Oven S'mores



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- Choose a box for your solar oven. A pizza box works well! You can also use a box with the bottom taped together with flaps on top. You will need to cut off one long flap and attach it to the flap on the other side with tape. You want a “lid” on your box that is attached like a hinge on one side.
- Line the bottom of your box with black construction paper.
- Cover the inside of the lid of your box with foil (heavy-duty works best!).
- If using a box with flaps, take one of the side flaps of your box and tape it to the lid lined in foil, so that it props the lid open. You can also use a stick or ruler to prop the lid open, and this works for a pizza box too!
- Place your graham crackers, marshmallows, and chocolate inside the box on a plate, pie tin, or oven dish. Cover the open part of your box with plastic wrap. Tape around 3 edges, leaving the front edge without tape so you can get the s'mores out.
- Leave in the sun on a hot day for about 30 minutes.
- Enjoy your snack!



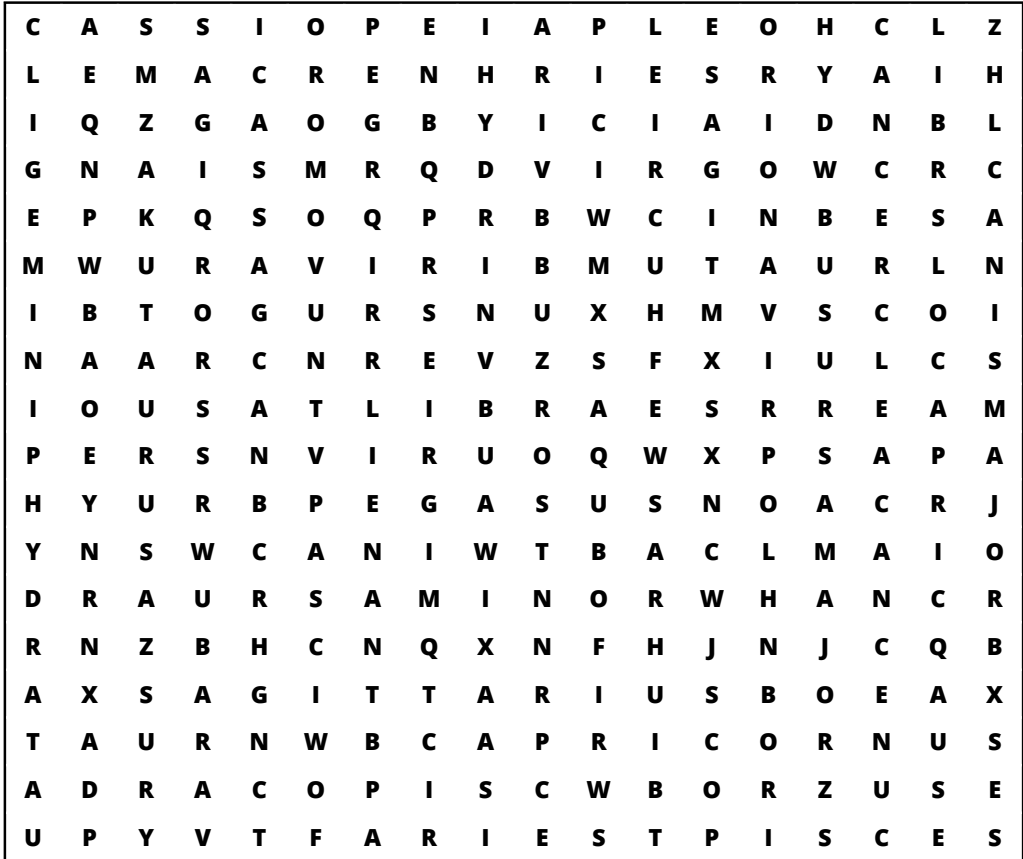
Science Experiments:

- How does the solar oven work? What is the foil on the lid doing to the sunlight? The plastic wrap? The black paper inside? Research a “greenhouse” to learn more!
- Which melts faster, the marshmallow or chocolate? Try cooking them
- separately in your oven and time how long each one takes!
- Try lining your box with foil instead of black construction paper.
- Does that cook what's inside faster or slower?
- Try other foods in your solar oven! Can you cook an egg, or make a quesadilla?

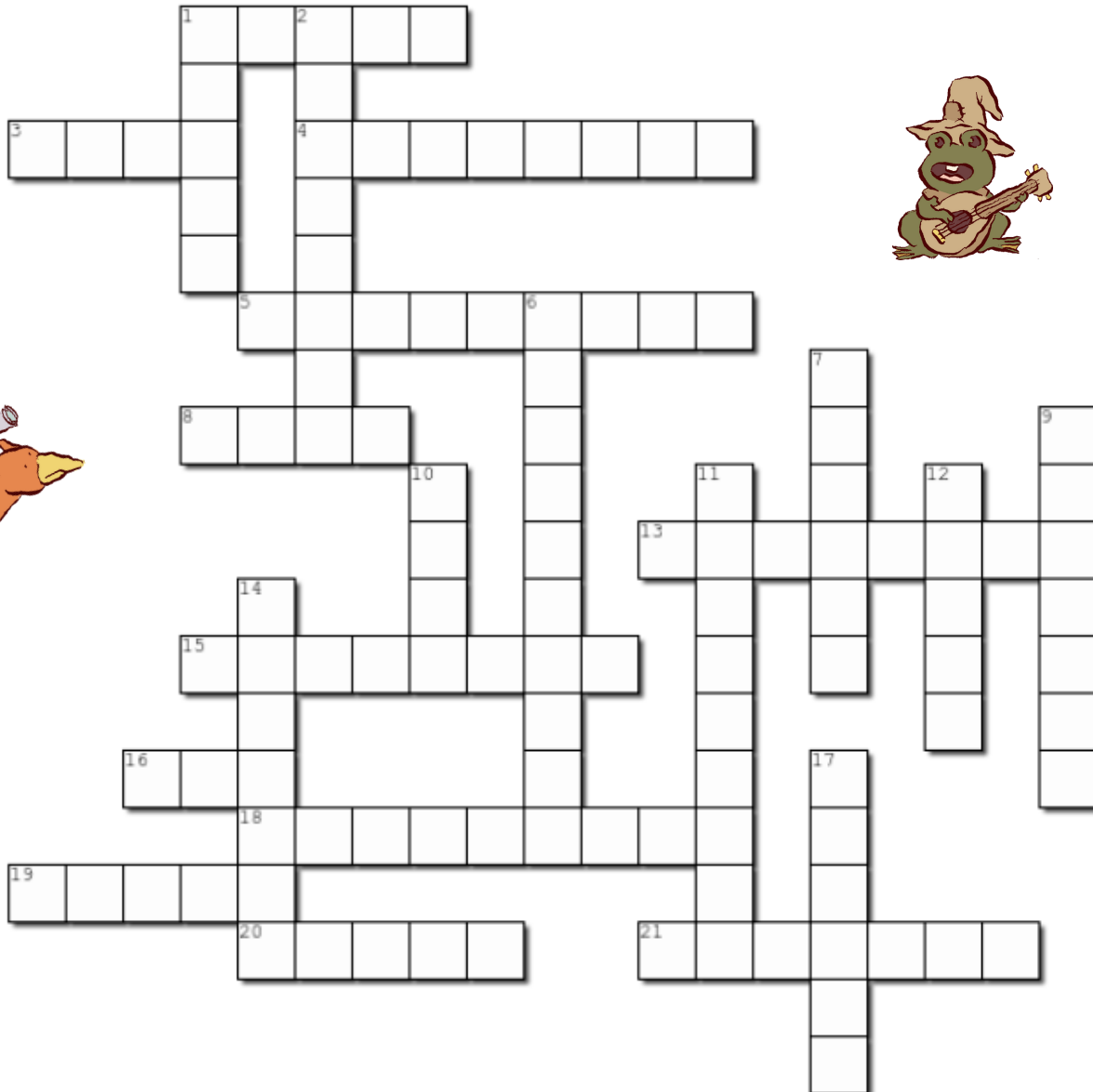
