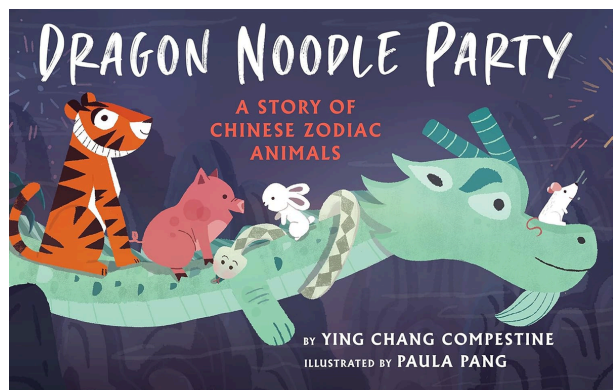


KINDERGARTEN READINESS TIPS

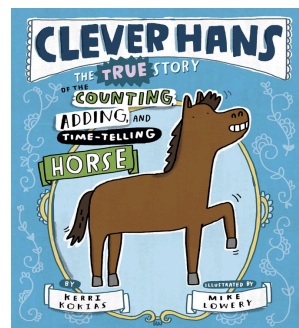
